MaD Olympiad Report

Pucklechurch Primary School went to Pomphrey Hill on Thursday to compete against all the other schools from the Mangotsfield and Downend area. Year 2 took part in the morning, before a group of key stage 2 children competed in a range of track and field activities in the afternoon.

First, year 2 competed in a range of multi skill activities including: On Target, Fun Relay, Hoop Fun, Egg and Spoon and Speed Bounce. Our best score then went to the scorekeepers. After this we competed in the track events: relay, 60m and egg and spoon.



After winning their heats, Rapha and Zoe both made it through to the egg and spoon final. Rapha ran a brilliant final and came out as the overall winner.



Meanwhile in the relay, both Armstrong SM and MN won their heats but unfortunately couldn't repeat the feat in the final. 32 children between the two classes took part in the relay and were fantastic. Milo then raced ahead in the 60m and never let up - he won the overall 60m against some seriously fast competition.

In the afternoon, children competed in the javelin, shot put, long jump, triple jump, 75m, 150m, 600m and the relay. All the children competed in heats in the track events and in the field events they had two goes with their best score going forward to the results.



Theo qualified for the 150m final and registered an excellent third, the long bend on the track made it a really challenging race to run. On the straight, Ben won his 75m heat and finished a very fast fourth in the

final. On the shot put, Loead saw off all-comers and recorded an individual victory. Rory then followed suit and received a bronze medal in his field event as well. The year 4s also then rounded off their successful individual performances by coming together to celebrate a third place overall finish for the year 4 competition.
