Find a calm, safe space and sit comfortably. Look around and name 5 things that you can see, then 4 things that you can touch, 3 things that you can hear, 2 things that you can taste (perhaps the fresh air on your tongue) and finally name one amazing thing about you.

Focussing on our senses can be very grounding as well as providing a distraction to help move past tricky moments.
