Smart phone free childhood         It is frequently in the media that children are spending an increasing amount of time on smart devices. Health professionals are reporting that too much screen time can have a detrimental effect on a child's attention span and ability to concentrate on other things. This concern has been echoed by thousands of parents nationwide and has been brought to our attention by some of our own Pucklechurch families through a movement called 'smart phone free childhood' which has useful resources for how to combat this.
