Emails to parents

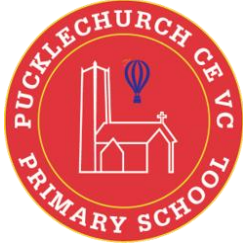

We email a weekly newsletter home each week with lots of information so please make sure you read this and refer to these as a first port of call.

Phone/email/speaking to the teacher

As mentioned earlier you can email your teacher if you aren't at school much but you can also phone to make an appointment or to speak them after school. If you are doing the school run then you can catch the teacher on the door but we do ask you try to let them welcome their classes in during the morning and make an appointment or catch them for anything in more detail after school. We aim to respond to emails within 3 working days.
